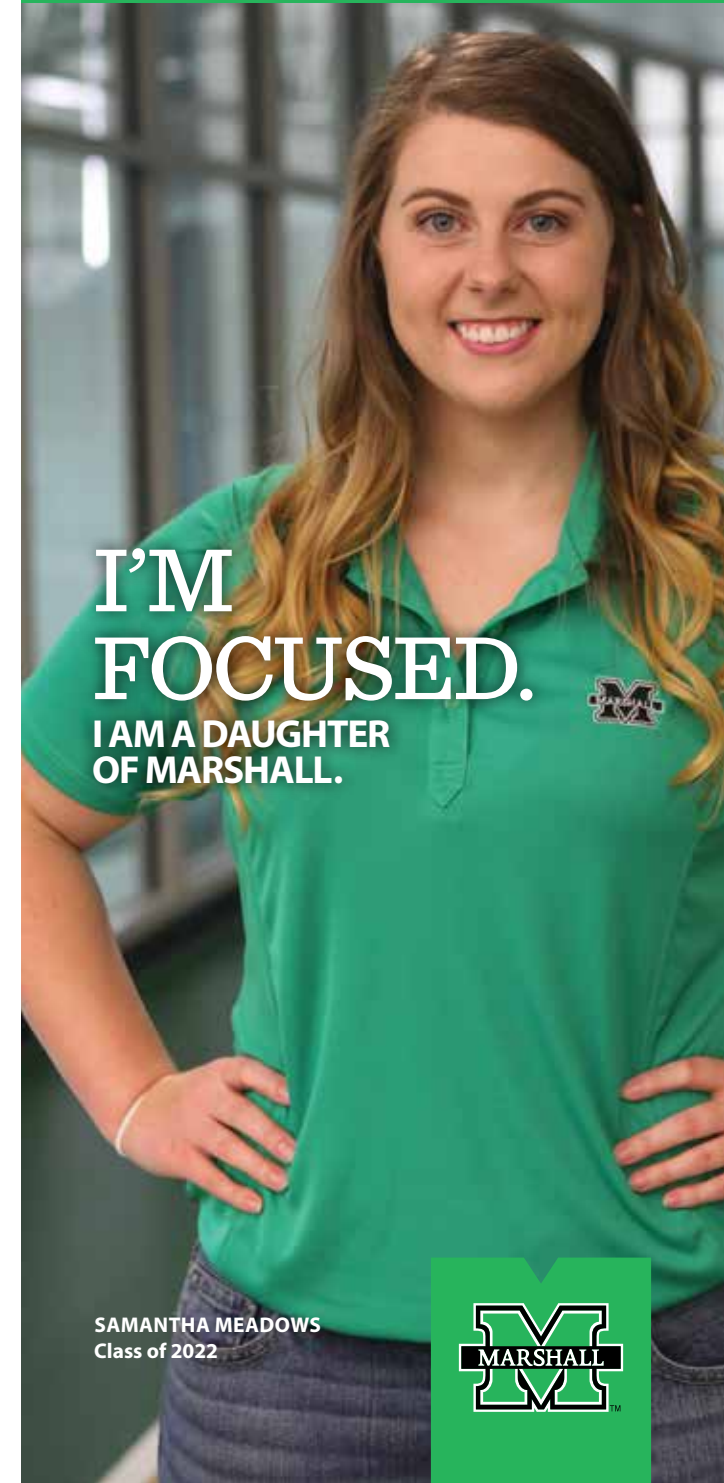

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the entry-level Doctor of Physical Therapy Program is on a competitive basis and requires completion of a baccalaureate degree and a minimum overall and prerequisite GPA of 3.0

Prerequisite Courses

- 8 credits of biology (including labs)
- 8 credits of chemistry (including labs)
- 8 credits of physics (including labs)
- 3 credits of human anatomy
- 3 credits of physiology
- 3 credits of statistics
- 6 credits of psychology (preferably abnormal, developmental, or lifespan)
