Program Description	<p>Touro University Nevada is a Jewish-sponsored, non-profit institution of higher education which offers programs in health sciences and education. Our vision is to educate caring professionals to serve, lead and teach, and our mission is to provide quality education programs in concert with the Judaic commitment to social justice, intellectual pursuit, and service to humanity.</p> <p>Our entry-level Doctor of Physical Therapy program is dedicated to preparing knowledgeable, skilled and caring practitioners who can assume and adapt to the multiple roles of a physical therapist in our ever-changing healthcare environment.</p> <p>The curriculum is designed to advance your capabilities in the realm of clinical care, education, and healthcare policy development. Residential classes use multi-formats of lecture, discussion, collaborative groups, interactive laboratories, and web-enhanced modules. On-line courses use multiple media such as streamed video, PowerPoint presentations with audio narration, discussion boards, real-time messaging, and student collaboration. Clinical learning is coordinated with community agencies and affiliated clinical practice sites offering physical therapy services in a variety of healthcare and educational settings. Students are supervised in clinical learning settings by licensed physical therapists who hold adjunct faculty appointments to TUN.</p> <p>Accreditation:</p> <p>Touro University Nevada has been approved by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges Accrediting Commission for Senior Colleges and Universities (WASC) to award the Doctor of Physical Therapy degree.
